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2020 NSW PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

At St Francis of Assisi School, we encourage all our students to read books at home as well as at school.

As a way of continuing to encourage our students to read, we are offering them the opportunity to participate in the **2020 NSW Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)**.

We will soon commence registering our students for this challenge. Students who successfully complete the challenge will receive a **Premier's Reading Challenge** certificate. The Premier's Reading Challenge no longer lists student names on an Honour Roll. However, there may be opportunities for students to be recognised through media publications or the school's newsletters and communications. No student names and/or details will be published publicly without prior consent from parents/ carers. As a school, we will also look at ways to honour our students' efforts in the challenge.

(Please note: the PRC Student Site requires Internet Explorer 11, Edge, or a current version of Firefox or Chrome). To complete the free challenge, students need to complete the reading requirements listed below, according to their year level. Reading for the 2020 PRC must be completed and **entered online by the end of August 2020**.

Challenge	Number of books you must read	Minimum number of PRC books	Maximum number of Personal Choice books	PRC booklists you can read from
K-2	30	25	5	K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-9
3-4	20	15	5	3-4, 5-6, 7-9
5-6	20	15	5	5-6, 7-9

Please note:

Teachers from K-2 will also read books in class time. These can be added to the challenge.

Years 3-4 and Years 5-6 students must read books on their own.

Our school library has a variety of PRC books. The books read by students may also include books from home and other libraries.

Once the permission note has been received, students will be registered online. Your child will then receive information about the rules and a reading log to fill in. After they have been registered, students need to enter their reading lists online. Students will be shown this process at school.
